Since 1968, Sheridan House Family Ministries has provided residential behavioral care for children in the tri-county area of South Florida.

Currently, we help families with boys (grades 6-9) who are experiencing behavioral difficulties including:

- School suspensions
- Failing grades
- Disruptive family behavior
- Immaturity
- Acting-out
- Impulsivity
- Defiance and/or disrespectful behavior
- Procrastination
- Poor attitude

The Sheridan House Residential Program is designed to intervene in the life of a family before dysfunctional behavior becomes a habitual lifestyle. Our objective is to provide the structure and environment that helps boys make the life changes necessary to accept responsibility for their behavior at home and school while developing essential life skills. For the boys, being in Sheridan House represents a fresh start rather than a punishment, as we strive to help them become the best version of themselves. For the parents, our desire is to equip and educate them so they can help their son graduate from the program and return home successfully. Our deepest hope is that during this process each family member will come to know Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and experience the personal love that God has for each of them.

Family Style Program

Sheridan House provides a strong family environment for the boys, intensive training for the parents, and a personalized weekend program for the family to follow when the boys return home every weekend and during school breaks. This time at home provides the boys and their parents opportunities to practice the skills they are taught. Each house is staffed with House Parents and a Behavior Specialist. Through supportive relationships and consistent accountability in a proven behavior modification program, we provide training in social skills, personal responsibility,

discipline, communication, conflict management, and effective problem solving for the residents and their parents. Academic education is provided on campus in a structured homeschool setting with the goal of helping the boys learn how to behave appropriately in class. While boys work at their own pace through the program, the average length of stay is 10-12 months.



One of the goals of the Residential Program is for the boys to experience what a healthy, loving family is like. Many of the boys come to us from strong families, and their time in the program reinforces what their parents have been trying to teach them. For some, however, the concept of "family" is a difficult one to grasp. One of the ways we strive to accomplish this is through mealtimes. As we explain to the boys' parents, mealtime is family time. It is more than simply eating together. This is a time for a family to come together - to be together. There are other times during the day to discuss behavioral issues. We believe that mealtime should be reserved for the purpose of bringing everyone together. Whether they are discussing sports, movies, or the highlights from their day, this is when we want the boys to look forward to being together as a family.



The Eagle Award is presented each month to the boy who deserves special recognition for his effort and/or achievement. Some boys receive the award because of the progress they are showing in school. Others receive it because of a turn-around they have made in their behavior at home. The Eagle Award provides the team in each Boys Home the opportunity to encourage one of the boys who needs an extra push, or who needs a special "atta boy!" Too many times, the boys in Sheridan House have received attention because of poor choices they have made. While in the program, they have the chance to receive positive attention and encouragement. Praise, affirmation, and recognition are powerful motivators for making changes in behavior because they sink in deep to reach the boy's heart. The Eagle Award is one of the many ways this is accomplished in the Residential Program.
